



Mayor's Education Award

The City of Warrensville Heights' Community & Economic Development Department manages the "**Mayor's Educational Award.**" The Mayor awards \$2,000 scholarships to high school seniors who have strived for, and exemplified outstanding scholastics, leadership and service within the Warrensville Heights School District. The scholarships are designed to help with college tuition, books, supplies and other college related expenses.

Criteria:

- Must be a Warrensville Heights High School senior graduating in the current academic year
- Must have cumulative GPA of 2.5 or higher
- Must be planning to attend and be **accepted** into a four year college or university

Application checklist (must include):

- One page essay about your educational and career goals, major, list of school activities and how you will use those achievements to succeed in life
- Copy of official high school transcript
- Letter of recommendation from a core class teacher (Math, English, Science or History)
- Copy of the acceptance letter from the college or university the student plans to attend
- Completed application
